## R evelina Mallari Obituary

Revelina Ortiz Mallari, 95, of Waipahu, Hawaii, passed away on March 10, 2025. She was born on January 27, 1930 in Urdaneta, Pangasinan, Philippines, the youngest of 4 children to Anastacia Elizaga and Eulalio Ortiz.

Revelina was widow to SSG (ret.) Lazaro A. Mallari, also from Pangasinan; they were married from 1956 to 1991.
