M arcelina Doseo Obituary

Marcelina (Marcy) Calderon Dolor Doseo, age 93 passed away peacefully at her home on Thursday, December 19, 2024 in Aiea, Hawaii.

Marcelina, daughter of the late Santiago Dolor and Marcela (Augustin), was born on June 1, 1931. Marcelina (Marcy) worked as an Administration Assistant for Holmes and Narver at Hickam Airforce base and retired in 1988. During Mom's retirement years she enjoyed managing the family farm in Captain Cook and was actively involved in various social clubs such as the Windward Orchid Society, the Cactus and Succulent Society of Hawaii, and the Ballroom Dance Association, where she enjoyed dancing the waltz and cha-cha at the Palladium.
