Warren Ideguchi Obituary

Warren Takeshi Ideguchi, or “Takeshi” as he was often called, passed away on November 6, 2024 in Scottsdale, Arizona surrounded by the comfort of loving family. He was 83 years old. Warren was the youngest son of Miyoshi and Tsuya Ideguchi. He was raised in Whitmore Village in Wahiawa, and graduated from Leilehua High school. Throughout his life, his interests included construction, cooking, golf, singing karaoke, gardening, watching all sports—especially golf, football, volleyball and baseball, and spending time with his children and grandchildren.

Warren worked in various capacities in the construction field, eventually specializing in drilling and blasting management. He took great pride in his work and always talked about how he could achieve great results without compromising safety.
