ROSEBELLA DELA CRUZ STEWART, 61 of Ewa Beach, passed away on June 8, 2024 in Honolulu, HI. She was born in #44 Zamboanga, Laoag City, Philippines and later migrated to O’ahu, Hawai’i in 1968, days before her fifth birthday. She went to Pohakea Elementary School, Our Lady of Perpetual Help (OLPH) and later graduated from James Campbell High School in 1981.

Rose was a driven entrepreneur having an extensive career with Avon, where she marketed beauty and personal care products to customers across the island.
