Passed Away: February 15, 2024, Vacaville, California

Preceding her in death are her parents Andres Tangil Garcia of Aiea and Juana Mamac of the Philippines, her husband Bernabe F. Andrade Sr., daughter Bernadette Madge O'Keefe, sisters Mary Kuaana and Rebecca Lester, and brother Samuel Garcia.

Surviving her are five children Richard Alan Andrade, Andrea Joan Garcia, Rebecca Andrade Parker, Cynthia Sue Andrade and Bernabe F. Andrade Jr.

Descendants include 19 grandchildren, 21 great grandchildren, and 8 great-great grandchildren.

She graduated from Farrington High School and married Bernabe Sr. on January 17, 1943. Madge held jobs as a car-hop in Manoa, waitress at SavMor Drugs at Kalihi Shopping Center, and a janitorial position with the public school system at Radford High School.
