AGRIFINA NIEGOS JULIO

Born on June 23, 1930, in Saverona, Munos, Nueva Ecija, Philippines. She was the oldest of nine children. Agrifina passed away on November 21, 2023 of kidney failure in Valley Medical Center at Renton, WA. She was more than ready to be with her soulmate.

Agrifina married Wallenstien B. Julio on May 14, 1951. After a short courtship, she realized that he was the love of her life. She often said that marrying Wallenstien and having his children was one of the greatest blessings in her life. They lived simply and happily and raised nine children.

Agrifina arrived in Hawaii in 1972 with her seven children to be with her husband, who emigrated first in 1969, followed shortly by their two oldest children. In August of 1979 they became Naturalized USA citizens, along with their five minor children.

She worked at Don the Beachcomber Hotel in Waikiki. She was a hard worker and enjoyed her interactions with her many co-workers, some of whom became her longtime friends. She retired from the Beachcomber in 1997. In 2003, Agrifina and Wallenstien relocated to the state of Washington and lived with their second oldest son and his family. Agrifina was able to fulfill her dreams and live a life full of love from her family.
