He spent a brief time in the Army, married his high school sweetheart, Winona Okamoto, and had three children. He worked as a carpenter at Pearl Harbor for most of his career. Divorced, he settled in with his long-time companion, Lois Pacolba, and was often seen bicycling in Waialua, greeting everyone with a smile and a friendly remark. He made the best pickled mango that he generously gave to friends and family. With his gentle nature, sense of humor and quick wit he always had a funny comment that could defuse any potential problem. He passed away peacefully at home on March 24, 2022. He is predeceased by his brothers Marciano (Gig), Teofilo (Teddy), and Estilito (Eddie), and his daughter, Earlyn Roylo Rabena. 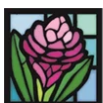
