On his days off he Aidan loved reading about dinosaurs, different species of animals, planes, and most recently, everything to do with the NFL and NBA players of the past and present. Aidan's passion for sports was paramount as he would spend his free time playing basketball and soccer or watching an NFL or NBA game. He would be glued to ESPN and everything on Sportscenter so he could be up to date on the latest news happening around the NFL and NBA. His two favorite teams were the Golden State Warriors and the Kansas City Chiefs and his two favorite players were Stephen Curry and Patrick Mahomes. Aidan's wish for Make-A-Wish was supposed to go and meet Steph Curry or go to a Warriors game, but with COVID, his wish like many other wish kids wasn't able to happen. He always held out hope that if he waited he would be able to see Steph or the Warriors.
