C arlos Maluyo Obituary

On Thursday, February 11, 2021, Carlos Maluyo, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and brother, passed away at the age of 93 years. He was born on December 4th, 1927 in Barangay Valdez, Marcos Ilocos Norte, Philippines and served in the United States Marines. He was awarded the Purple Heart medal (wounded in the Korean War in 1952), Korean Service Medal with two stars, United Nations service medal, and the National Defense Service Medal. He was honorably discharged in 1959 and later became a Painter Rough for the Honolulu Painting Company where he was awarded Painter of the Year for three years.
