He was born in Tacoma, Washington. Todd is a 1988 Na Hoku winner with the group Nightwing. His other accomplishments are: 1998 Hawaii Music Award winner for Producer of the Year, 2000 Hawaii Music Award winner for Studio Musician of the Year, and for Liner Notes on his Peace by Peace CD.
