Inurnment to follow, 2:00 pm at Mililani Memorial Park Cemetery.



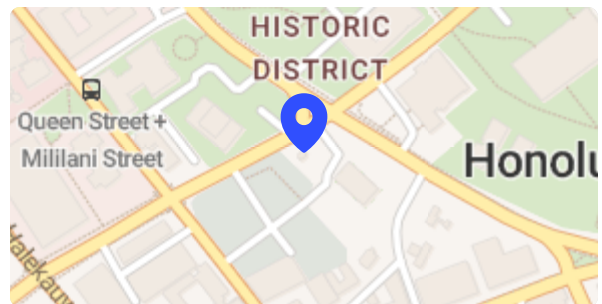

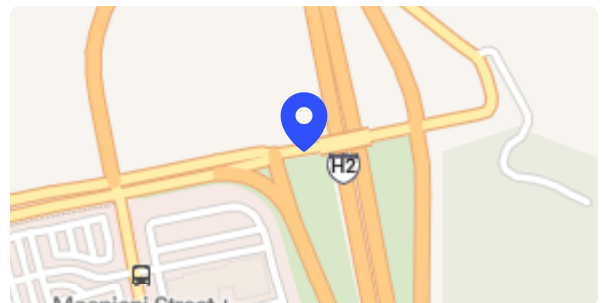
